Non-Immigrant Work Visas

Sanford successfully petitions the Immigration Service on behalf of companies and individuals that are trying to obtain work permission in the United States. He regularly files H1Bs, L1s, O-1s, and TNs and is proficient in developing customized immigration plans for clients who are seeking employment permission and obtaining permanent residency in the United States.

PERM

Sanford assists employers and employees through the green card process known as PERM.

Immigrant Petitions/Consular Proceedings

Sanford assists clients in obtaining Permanent Residency through Adjustment of Status petitions based on approved PERM Applications or through filing an I-140 petition in an EB1 or EB2 category, including Extraordinary Ability, Outstanding Researcher or Outstanding Professor and Multi-National Executive.
